In 1978 he was transferred to the Chemistry and Biology Research Institute where he probed and resolved many problems of the effect of microbial activity on mineral transformations in soils.

Dr. Ivarson's wish is to provide financial support to students entering second or subsequent year of postgraduate studies in soil science (in areas of agriculture, agro ecology, resource management, environment, geology or other related disciplines) at a recognized Canadian University. Two \$2000 scholarships will be offered in 2010. Application deadline is November 5, 2010.
