

Guidance Statement for the Grindley Medal

1. The AIC Board of Directors may present the Grindley Medal to a Canadian who has made a singular contribution to Canadian agriculture, the impact of which has been far-reaching and recognized within the past five years.
2. The Grindley Medal shall be made only on unanimous approval of the Board of Directors for a truly significant contribution to Canadian agriculture.
3. Any Association Member of AIC or any five individual members of AIC may make nominations.
4. Knowledge of nominations shall be held in strict confidence by those making nominations.
5. “Singular” means **one particular identifiable contribution**. The objective in making the Grindley Medal award is to publicly recognize such a contribution by a Canadian as soon as possible after the impact on Canadian agriculture (or a portion thereof) has taken place.
6. Nominations must be supported by documentary evidence as to the character, experience and accomplishments of the nominee, including activities outside his/her professional discipline.
7. Nominations and supporting documentation must be received at the AIC office by **April 30**
