

## Guidance Statement and Rules for International Partners Award

---

### Guidance Statement

The AIC International Partners Award is presented in recognition of those who have made, and continue to make, outstanding efforts to improve agriculture in the Developing World.

In making this award, the AIC particularly wishes to give recognition to those who have had a noticeable impact on research, teaching, management, or communications in collaboration with agricultural institutions in the Developing World. Recipients will not be members of the AIC.

Awards may be given for a wide variety of activities. Among these are:

- Long-term efforts in the development and management of programs, projects and activities that have had a positive effect on the evolution of agriculture research, institution building or training in the Developing World.
- Significant contributions to the training of agriculture students in international development in Canada or to the training of students in the Developing World.
- Outstanding contributions to agricultural research that have been adapted to the needs of developing country agriculture and have achieved international recognition and impact.
- Responsibility for the implementation of activities that have made recognized positive contributions to the scientific and professional advancement of agriculture in the Developing World.
- Important contributions to the successful management of research programs, research organizations, or extension services in the Developing World.

Any partner in international agricultural development may be nominated for this award. The person or group will not be a member of AIC, but an Association Member of AIC must endorse nominations.

### Rules

1. (a) One award may be presented each year. The Honours and Awards Committee may, in exceptional circumstances, choose to honour additional nominees.  
(b) Recipients will be presented with the award, which will have no monetary value, at the AIC Honours and Awards presentations ceremony.  
(c) AIC will not cover the travel expenses of the recipients to come to Canada to receive the award.
2. Contributions of the individual must be of recognized international merit or have the potential for application in other countries or regions.
3. An Association Member of AIC or any five members of an Association Member of AIC may make nominations. As noted above a Member Association of AIC must endorse the nomination.
4. Nominations must be supported by documentary evidence of the character, contributions and accomplishments of the nominee(s).

5. Nominations and documentation, must be received at the AIC office, no later than April 30 for consideration by the Honours & Awards Committee and recommendation to the AIC Board of Directors. Unsuccessful nominations may be re-documented and resubmitted in subsequent years. Unsuccessful nominations will not automatically be brought forward for next year.
6. Those making the nomination(s) shall hold knowledge of nomination(s) in confidence.
7. The Honours and Awards Committee will make the selection.
