

Guidance Statement and Rules for AIC International Recognition Award

The AIC International Recognition Award is presented in recognition of members of AIC who have made, and continue to make, outstanding efforts to improve agriculture in the Developing World.

In making this award, the AIC particularly wishes to give recognition to those who have had a noticeable impact on research, teaching, management, or communications in collaboration with agricultural institutions in the Developing World.

Awards may be given for a wide variety of activities. Among these are:

- Long-term efforts in the development and management of programs, projects and activities that have had a positive effect on the evolution of agriculture research, institution building or training in the Developing World.
- Significant contributions to the training of agriculture students in international development in Canada or to the training of students in the Developing World.
- Outstanding contributions to agricultural research that have been adapted to the needs of developing country agriculture and have achieved international recognition and impact.
- Responsibility for the implementation of activities that have made recognized positive contributions to the scientific and professional advancement of agriculture in the Developing World.
- Important contributions to the successful management of research programs, research organizations, or extension services in the Developing World.

Nominations

- Nominations must be made by two or more AIC Members who either jointly sign the nomination forms, or provide and sign two separate letters of nomination.
- Good documentation is essential.
- Any member of an AIC in good standing may be nominated for this award with the exception of institutions, corporations, and persons elected by popular vote to federal, provincial or municipal governments.
- Candidates cannot make a personal application for the award.

Rules

1. One award may be presented each year. The Honours and Awards Committee may, in exceptional circumstances, choose to honour additional nominees.
2. Canadians will be presented with the award, which will have no monetary value, at the AIC Honours and Awards presentations ceremony.
3. Contributions of the individual must be of recognized international merit or have the potential for application in other countries or region
4. Two AIC members as nominators may make nominations.
5. Nominations must be supported by documentary evidence of the character, contributions and accomplishments of the nominee(s).
6. The Honours & Awards Committee must receive nominations, including documentation, at the AIC office, **no later than April 30** for consideration. Unsuccessful nominations may be re-documented and resubmitted in subsequent year, but will not automatically be brought forward for next year.
7. Those making the nomination(s) shall hold knowledge of nomination(s) in confidence.
8. The Honours and Awards Committee will make the selection.
