

## Guidance Statement for the Outstanding Young Agrologist Award

---

The Agricultural Institute of Canada offers this award to Professional Agrologists who are under forty (40) years of age as of April 30 of the year of nomination. The award recognizes outstanding achievement(s) and service to Agriculture in Canada.

Nominees must be a member in good standing of AIC.

### Rules Governing the Award

1. An Association Member of AIC or any five members of AIC may make nominations.
2. Those making nominations shall hold knowledge of nominations in strict confidence.
3. Nominations must be completed on the form provided by the AIC.
4. Nominations and supporting documentation must be received at the AIC office **no later than April 30.**
5. Unsuccessful nominations may be resubmitted in following years.
6. There may be more than one Outstanding Young Agrologist award presented in any given year. (November 2001)
7. Recipients must hold the designation of P.Ag. (Professional Agrologist) or Tech.Ag. (Technical Agrologist). (November 2001)

## **Notes on Career Achievements**

**1. Administration**

**3. Extension**

- (a) Extension projects initiated and adapted
- (b) Stature attained through services

**4. Research**

- (a) Quantity and quality of original research projects and publications
- (b) Acceptance and adaptation of research findings

**5. Teaching**

- (a) Stature attained through teaching and leadership
- (b) Quantity and quality of original research projects and publications

Documentation for a nominee may be given in more than one category. For instance, a nominee who has achieved outstanding success as a researcher may also have worked with various extension projects, or as a teacher.

To aid the Honours and Awards Committee in their assessment of a nominee, it is important that research projects and publications are listed and positive action which developed from this research be properly documented.

Supplementary statements by members of the nominating organization giving reasons why the nominee should be awarded an Outstanding Young Agrologist Award may also be attached.
