

 - 3. Improve & automate business processes.



CHALLENGE TO AGRICULTURE INDUSTRY OVERALL (FAO)

- Current world population 7.5B forecasted to increase to 9B by 2050
- Will require a 70% increase in amount of food currently produced
- Labor shortages in agriculture in Canada ~>\$2B in lost revenues according to Canadian Agriculture Human Resources Council (2019)
- Arable land for agriculture is declining
- Will Canada be a global leader?
