Global / National Context

- Climate Change and Resource Scarcity (water and food)
- Globalization v. Economic Nationalism
- Technological change and automation are disrupting sectors of the economy
 - Unemployment and underemployment
 - youth, aboriginals, new Canadians
 - Business investment in Canada is low
 - R&D expenditures have fallen steadily since 2011





Government of Canada Economic Priorities

Growth for the Middle Class

 establishing Canada as a centre of global innovation, and investing in infrastructure to deliver sustained economic growth.

A Clean Growth Economy

 positioning Canada to take advantage of opportunities in the new global economy while reducing emissions and generating well-paying jobs.

A Better Future for Indigenous Peoples

 working in partnership with Indigenous peoples to break down the barriers that have held back individuals and communities from reaching their full potential.





Budget 2017 Innovation and Skills Plan

Canada's Innovation and Skills Plan aims to help Canadian workers and companies adapt to a rapidly changing economy.

Four key themes:

- Skills
- Research, Technology, Commercialization
- Investment and Scale-up
- Program Simplification





I&S Plan: Skills

- Northern Adult Basic Education Program
 - Training for residents of the 3 territories (\$14.7M/3y for CanNor)
- Youth Employment Strategy
 - Help 33,000 youth find work/go back to school;
 - Creating 15,000 green job and 1,600 heritage sector internships. (ESDC) (\$395.5M/3y)
- Canada 150 Research Chair Programs
 - (\$117.6M/8y)
- Global Skills Strategy
 - Temporary Foreign Worker Program and the International Mobility Program (\$279.8M/5y and \$49.8M ongoing)
 - New Global Talent Stream (\$7.8M/2y)
 - New work permit exemption for short-duration work terms and short-term, intercompany work/study exchanges



1&S Plan: Research, Tech, Commercialization (1)

Innovation Superclusters Initiative

Support for a small number of business-led innovation superclusters enhancing global competitiveness in highly innovative industries (\$950M/5y)

Strategic Innovation Fund

Consolidating and simplifying business innovation programming in automotive and aerospace sectors while expanding support to other sectors (\$1.26B/5y)

Impact Canada Fund

- Clean technology (\$75M/2y) to help rural and remote communities reduce their reliance on diesel as a power source
- Smart cities (\$300M/11y)





1&S Plan: Research, Tech, Commercialization (2)

- Access to Growth Capital for Clean Technology
 - Increasing financing support to clean tech firms (~\$1.4B from BDC/EDC)
- Sustainable Development Technology Canada (SDTC)
 - Recapitalizing the SD Tech Fund™ (\$400M/5y)
- International Business Development
 - Supporting clean tech firms to become global leaders (GAC) (\$15M/4y)
- Clean Growth in the Natural Resources Program
 - Supporting research, development, demonstration and adoption of clean tech in natural resources sectors (NRCan, AAFC, DFO) (\$200M/4y)
- Clean Energy and Transport
 - Investing in R&D for clean energy and transportation (NRCan/TC) (\$229M/4y)
- **Expanding Tax Support for Clean Energy**
 - Expanding accelerated capital cost allowance provisions to geothermal (FC)





1&S Plan: Investment and Scale-up

- **Innovative Solutions Canada**
 - Launching a new procurement program for early-stage R&D, late-stage prototypes from Canadian innovators and entrepreneurs (\$50M/5y)
- Venture Capital Catalyst Initiative
 - Providing \$400M on a cash basis through BDC over 3 years for late-stage venture capital
- Canadian Business Growth Fund
 - Creating a \$500M investment fund with contributions from Canadian financial institutions to support promising small and medium-sized firms (private sector)
- Futurpreneur
 - Financing and mentorship for young entrepreneurs (\$14M/2y)





Program Simplification

- **Innovation Canada**
 - Comprehensive review of federal innovation programs
 - Create economic growth strategies
 - Identifying innovation opportunities in: advanced manufacturing, agri-food, clean tech, digital industries, health/bio-sciences, and clean resources.
 - Review effectiveness and efficiency of SRED
 - In time, serve as a one-stop shop for Canada's innovators and entrepreneurs





Western Economic Diversification

- Funds projects to develop and diversify Western Canada's economy.
- WD's primary tools are grants and contributions programs: the Western Diversification Program (WDP); and, the Western Innovation Initiative (WINN).
 - WDP and WINN are both delivered through a call for proposals process.
 - WDP call for proposals closed on February 23, 2017.
 - Since 2014, WD has invested nearly \$97 million in 85 projects through WINN.

- Support for Agricultural Innovation
 - Budget 2017 \$70M/6y to focus on discovery science
 - Budget 2016 \$30M/6y for advanced research
- Next Agriculture Policy Framework
 - To be launched in 2018
