Following doctoral studies at McGill University, he co-ordinated the Toronto Food Policy Council for 10 years, then worked for 10 years as a consultant to governments, businesses and NGOs on projects to advance sustainable food systems in Canada.

He's currently an associate professor in the Faculty of Environmental and Urban Change at York University. With more than 150 publications, his analysis is frequently used to design policies, programmes and NGO and business strategies.
