**Dr. Rene Van Acker** is Professor and Dean of the Ontario Agricultural College at the University of Guelph and was previously a professor of weed science and crop management at the University of Manitoba.

Dr. Van Acker's research interests include weed biology and ecology, robust cropping systems, multifunctional agriculture and the coexistence of GM and non-GM crops. He conducts field-based research, supervises graduate students, and teaches courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels. He has published over 130 peer reviewed works to-date and has made over 350 other non-peer reviewed contributions.

He holds B.Sc. and M.Sc. degrees in crop science and weed management from the University of Guelph and a PhD in crop-weed ecology from the University of Reading in the United Kingdom
